**FH/11/02980/DOMNP - Mr. M. Cameron, 1, Grailands Close, Fernhurst, Haslemere. Detached single storey garage.**

It was proposed by Mr. Self and seconded by Mrs. Bicknell that the Parish Council recommends approval of the application. Carried.

**FH/11/03120/FULNP - Mr. C. Woods, Hampden, Fernden Lane, Haslemere. Variation of permission FH/08/02573/FUL – red bricks under slate roof as opposed to render elevations under a slate roof.**

It was proposed by Mrs. Pezier and seconded by Mrs. Bicknell that the Parish Council recommends approval of the application. Carried.

**FH/11/03218/DOMNP - Mr. & Mrs. M. Sherlock, Ingleby House, Whites Lane, Henley Common, Fernhurst. Extension to and conversion of existing property to form a 5 bedroom detached house. Demolition of existing bothy/office and various other outbuildings. Erection of detached garage/stables/home office.**

Mr. Harding, who had visited the site, reported that there would be no overlooking of other properties and proposed that the Parish Council recommends approval of the application. Seconded by Mr. Self and carried.

**EB/11/03374/EXTNP - City and Country Group plc, King Edward VII site, Easebourne. Extension to planning permission EB/08/01501/FUL – Partial demolition, extension and alterations to existing buildings for continued class C” use and associated landscaping.**

It was proposed by Mr. Self and seconded by Mrs. Pezier that Fernhurst Parish Council objects to the renewal of this application, being extremely concerned about the effect of additional traffic at the junction of Kings Drive and the A286 and the generally adverse effects on the local infrastructure, including water supply, sewage disposal, schools and health services, together with the demand for additional parking at Haslemere station where parking provision is already insufficient for current users.

It is noted that the present applicants gave no credence to the original application when it consulted with the parish council and the general public on the development of the site, so it is difficult to understand why they now wish to renew this permission. Carried.
