

FERNHURST PARISH COUNCIL

A meeting of the Planning Applications Committee took place at Fernhurst Village Hall on Monday 30th July 2012 at 6.00 p.m.

SDNP/12/00481/HOUS - The Forge, Henley Common, Fernhurst. Two storey extension to north elevation.

It was proposed by Mr. Cottam and seconded by Mrs. Braithwaite that the Parish Council recommends approval of the application. Carried.

SDNP/12/00988/TPO - 19, Southleys, Fernhurst. Reduce limbs by up to 4m on East side of the upper crown on 1 no. Oak tree (quoted as T") but is T5 subject to FH/92/00474/TPO.

It was proposed by Mrs. Bicknell and seconded by Mr. Chapman that the Parish Council recommends approval of the application. Carried.

SDNP/12/01328/TPO - Oakwood, 24, The Leys, Fernhurst. Reduce the limbs on the east side of the upper crown only by up to 4m to reduce overhang of adjoining property.

It was proposed by Mrs. Bicknell and seconded by Mr. Chapman that the Parish Council recommends approval of the application. Carried.

SDNP/12/00471/FUL - Wealden Edge, Square Drive, Fernhurst. Erection of a replacement dwelling.

It was proposed by Mr. Cottam and seconded by Mr. Harding that the Parish Council recommends approval of the application. Carried.

SDNP/12/00497/HOUS - Little Hoewycks, Lickfold Road, Fernhurst. Construction of conservatory to existing annexe and storm porch to east elevation.

It was proposed by Mrs. Bicknell and seconded by Mrs. Braithwaite that the parish Council recommends approval of the application. Carried.

SDNP/12/00935/FUL - Rosemary Park Nursing Home, Marley Common, Fernhurst. Construction of 2/3 storey side extension to create 20 additional ensuite bedrooms.

No discussion took place in relation to this application. The details had been passed to the Clerk of Lynchmere Parish Council, in whose area this property will be from 1st April 2013, so that they make any comment they so choose.
